

Equipment Fact Sheet: Cricut Maker

What it's used for:

- The Cricut Maker is a craft cutting machine, allowing you to cutdifferent types of craft materials. The most common are vinyl stickers, iron ons, craft paper, & fabrics.
- Create stickers to decorate your phone, computer, mugs, windows, or any other surface.
- Create iron on designs for t-shirts, sweaters, hats, or any other fabric.



Specs:

- The Cricut Maker is able to make cuts on a piece of material that is 355mm X 355mm or 12X12 inches.
- With two different blades, the Cricut Maker can cut through fabrics, cardstock, and vinyl.

Hardware and Materials:

- The Cricut Maker uses a variety of Grip Mats to feed material into the cutter. Be sure to use the proper grip for the proper material.
- The Cricut Maker comes with many useful tools to make removing excess material from your design, and transferring your project to its new home, easy. These tools include tweezers, picks, scoring stylus, scoring wheel, scissors, and scrapers.

Software:

- To create and send your project to the Cricut Maker, you will be using the <u>Cricut Design Space</u>. You can create your own account to keep all your projects in one space.
